Veterinary Inspection Certificate for Bulls Entered for Society Sales

This form, to be completed by a qualified veterinary surgeon, must accompany any bull to be sold at a Beef Shorthorn Society Sale, including on farm sales, (except Perth Bull Sales where inspections are carried out at the market.), and should be handed to the Auctioneer to be passed on to the purchaser.

The inspection must be carried out **no more than 30 days before the sale date.**

The bull must be examined, with regard to the following criteria:

Teeth: The teeth must make proper contact with the dental pad of the upper jaw, and the lower jaw must not be severely undershot or overshot.

Testicles: The circumference of the bull's testicles must be measured at the widest point of the scrotum, and must attain the following minimum measurements:-

Bulls under 18 months – 32 cms

Bulls 18 to 24 months – 34 cms

Bulls over 24 months – 35 cms

The testicles must also be of equal size, with normal conformation and consistency.

General Health: The bull must be in good general health and free from active infections or contagious disease.

I have examined the above mentioned bull. His scrotal measurement iscms and he fulfils the other requirements listed above.
